Angel Great, Bobby Grich, Shared His Appreciation For Life and Baseball

BOBBY GRICH was our speaker on June 11th. He graciously came early to sign autographs and take pictures with everyone. He is a favorite with the Boosters and is always a welcome speaker. He tells good stories and gives us great information about himself and baseball in general. There is too much to cover here, so next time he speaks, we hope you can come to the meeting.

Bobby grew up in Long Beach and always wanted to play for the Angels. When Angel Stadium was built in 1966, Bobby was a junior in high school and went to many games there where he watched Jim Fregosi, Bobby Knoop and other Angels legends play.

Bobby and Davey Johnson played together in the minors. In 1970 while he was with the AAA Orioles team, Bobby was called up. He played short stop and 2nd base and earned a World Series Ring in 1970, but the following year he went back to the minors because Davey was playing 2nd base for the Orioles. Bobby won Minor League Player Of The Year in 1971 with a .280 batting average. When Davey was traded, Bobby was called up to play 2nd base.

Bobby explained how free agency grew from its inception and the problems that existed in its early days. This led to the Curt Flood vs. Bowie Kuhn Supreme Court case which solidified the players resolve and redefined the rules for free agency. Bobby was in his 6th year when he joined the Angels as a free agent, joining Don Baylor and Joe Rudy as the 3 free agents that year.

Once, a bat boy named Kevin Uhlich asked Bobby how the Angels team differed from the Orioles where Bobby had played previously. Bobby told him he felt there was much more of a family atmosphere that was missing with the Angels players. Well, Kevin grew up, went to college, and went to work for the Angels. He worked his way up from bat boy in 1976 to V.P. in 1999. In 2002, Kevin hired Bobby to help develop a legacy plan for the Angels to create a better sense of family. That year, 4 or 5 former players were persuaded to go to spring training and this year, eight former players were at spring training to mentor and encourage the players.

Bobby gave us some insight into players, saying he felt that Macier Izturis had some of the best hands in baseball at second base, that Shohei Ohtani seems to be a great kid, and that Mike Trout continues to work hard, coming to spring training in better shape every year.

Bobby seems to be a man who appreciates the opportunities and the relationships he has had in his life. His baseball family is important and the happiness of his personal family is paramount. Because of baseball, Bobby felt he was lucky to travel around the U.S. and the world. He regaled us with tales of his travels. He found great beauty and inspiration in the natural vistas and historical sites he visited. He has a great story about his encounter with President Richard Nixon, but that article will have to be for another time.
