Not only is Jay Paris a celebrated sports journalist and author, but he is also a former member of the Angels Booster Club from back in the 1970s.

Paris, who was once a paper boy for the "Santa Ana Register" has written three books: "Game Of My Life Chargers," "Game Of My Life Rams," and his latest, "Shohei Ohtani The Amazing Story Of Baseball's Two-Way Japanese Superstar."

Paris, a Orange High graduate, has worked for the Orange County Register, the San Diego Union Tribune and the North County Times, where he covered the San Diego Chargers for more than 20 years. He now writes about the NFL in LA for forbes.com and is a three-time recipient of awards from the Pro Football Writers Association of America.

He currently covers baseball for mlb.com and the Associated Press as a Hall of Fame voting member of the Baseball Writers' Association of America.

Paris is the proud married father of two sons and he lives with his family in Cardiff, just north of San Diego.

Jay Paris will bring the Shohei Ohtani book and his book on the Rams, where 20 Rams legends pick the most favorite game of their lives. Each book is \$20.

With all of the rainy weather we have been having I was very appreciative to everyone who attended the February meeting. I know many people were looking forward to hearing Trent Rush speak, especially after hearing him speak last year. Unfortunately, he was sick and unable to attend the meeting.

Marcia from PCAA came and spoke and updated us on the many ways the members can help PCAA. The Booster Club has been working with PCAA for the past 18 years and it is always nice having the opportunity to hear what PCAA does for the community and how we help them do it. Currently, PCAA's focus is on two probation schools and more alternatives to juvenile hall. One of these alternatives is "Thinking for a Change", which is more of a transitional program that teaches life skills. The other two programs are "Paws (Pups and Wards) program" and "Giving Back". With "Giving Back" the two youth reporting centers or probation

schools are school environments where the teens are rewarded for succeeding. The teens also do service projects where they make pillow cases for the children at CHOC and blankets for the homeless.

The Booster Club's support helps PCAA provide the schools with supplies and the rewards that they give out. The club also provided PCAA, through the toy drive, the ability to provide 120 gifts at Christmas time to the two probation schools.

PCAA is planning another lunch sometime this spring which will provide The Booster Club the opportunity to do more for the youth in the community.

Thank you to all our members who put so much effort into our volunteer activities. It is because of all of you that we are able to positively impact the Orange County/Angels community. ☺


Any help on any of those days would be greatly appreciated. Please let me know if you can help.
